1 Approved Errata for ECF Core 5.01

- Following are the approved errata to the Electronic Court Filing v5.01 Committee Specification. All references schemas are provided with the [ECF-v5.01] specification.

1.1 Reference to ecf:CasePartySelfRepresentationIndicator

In Section 6.5 Case Participant Rules, replace the second paragraph with the following:

The `CaseParticipantRoleCode.gc` code list defines the allowed values for `ecf:CaseParticipantRoleCode` and includes columns indicating which code values are valid in combination with each role element. If `ecf:CaseParticipantRoleCode` is provided, the code value MUST be in the `CaseParticipantRoleCode.gc` code list and the code list column matching the role element MUST have the value “true”. Parties not represented by an attorney should be represented with `ecf:CaseParty` with a `ecf:CasePartySelfRepresentationIndicator` value of “true”.
