Rather, the rest of the document refers to Policy Definitions as components of a Service Template. 2	Operational model	Section 4 (TOSCA Operational model), last paragraph, begins with the following sentence: "Note that it is not mandatory for compliant TOSCA implementations to four kinds of TOSCA abstractions defined in Section 2.4 support all three service lifecycle phases.". The meaning is almost clear, but I think that the sentence should be slightly rephrased.
